Minor (Level I) Violations	Level I Sanctions
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Disruptive behavior, disobedience ▪ Truancy and other status offenses ▪ Failure to report as directed ▪ Curfew violation ▪ Association with prohibited persons ▪ Failure to pay supervision fee or restitution, or failure to complete community service ▪ Minor school infractions (not involving new offenses) ▪ First positive drug screen ▪ Leaving home without permission (returns on his/her own) ▪ Other non-compliance with general or specific terms and conditions of probation/supervision 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Verbal warning by probation officer ▪ Written warning by probation officer ▪ Increased reporting instructions or contact with child and/or parent/guardian ▪ Additional restrictions or conditions (e.g., tightening of curfew, more community service hours, etc.) ▪ Referral to the court's internal programs (e.g., diversion workshops, CHOICES) ▪ Referral to external programs (that do not require court funding) ▪ Reassessment and revision to treatment plan
Moderate (Level II) Violations	Level II Sanctions
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ A second Level I Violation ▪ Second failed drug screen ▪ Failure to attend substance abuse or sex offender treatment program ▪ A new offense involving a non-violent misdemeanor 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Multiple Level I Sanctions ▪ Home confinement with electronic monitoring for 14 days* ▪ Referral to the Evening Reporting Center* ▪ Referral to FAST-START program with follow-up on recommendations* ▪ Referral to Multi-Systemic Therapy* ▪ Administrative Review*
Serious (Level III) Violations	Level III Sanctions
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ A third Level I Violation ▪ A second Level II Violation ▪ Running away from home (whereabouts unknown) ▪ Extensive or ongoing substance abuse ▪ A new offense involving a misdemeanor where violence occurs or there was a substantial threat of violence ▪ A new offense involving a felony offense 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Multiple Level II Sanctions* ▪ Judicial Review* ▪ Formal violation of probation/supervision with or without warrant*
