The 2023 Andrew Smith Award is presented to Shalain Garcia of New York. Shalain is recognized for her contributions to addressing racial and ethnic disparities in the youth justice system. The Coalition for Juvenile Justice is honored to present this award to Shalain for her outstanding dedication to racial justice.



The award is named to pay tribute to Andrew Smith, an incredible voice for youth and a pivotal Racial and Ethnic Disparities Coordinator. Mr. Smith served as New Hampshire's Racial and Ethnic Disparities Coordinator and was responsible for the creation of the Mirror Project, an effort to bring together law enforcement and youth.
