A limited number of applicants will be selected for an interview during the review process. If an applicant is selected for an interview, they will be contacted directly. Due to the volume of applicants, not all candidates will be contacted.

The ideal applicant will have the following experiences, skills, and qualities:

- Have not yet reached the age of 27;
- Is a member of their State Advisory Group;
- Has previous or current juvenile justice involvement (i.e., aftercare, detention, incarceration, parole probation and/or residential placement.) and/or interested in juvenile justice reform;
- Has writing and/or public speaking skills;
- Is able to work well with others; and
- Is eager to learn and listen.

Applicants with lived experience and/or members of their State Advisory Group are strongly encouraged to apply.
